IMPORTANT DETAILS

Please bring a valid ID. You must be 18 years of age or older to participate.

DDO dogs must be approved by staff before heading out. A preapproved list of dogs is updated every Wednesday and is available to view at our shelter.

Pick up a dog anytime **before** 2 PM, and return them to the shelter by 4 PM.

Bring your own slip leash. We will provide you with an "Adopt Me" leash sleeve.
