- A. Operation Update, July 2021. Jennifer Smith provided statistics for completed calls for service, average response time, daily kennel census, volunteer hours, animals fostered, animals rescued, trapped, altered and released cats, pets returned to home, and outcome of Adopt-A-Palooza event.
- B. Petco Love Lost Program. Mavis Williamson shared information regarding Petco Love Lost, which is a new national program of reuniting families with their lost pet(s). Ms. Williamson presented Stanislaus Animal Services Agency's plan on implementing the program for Stanislaus County.
- C. Grant Award from California Animal Welfare Funders Collaborative. Stanislaus Animal Services Agency received a grant in the amount of \$7,500 to increase reunification of pets. The grant will support microchip clinics scheduled for the Fall of 2021. The events will take place on weekends throughout Stanislaus County. The City of Modesto's event will take place in October at the Modesto Center Plaza. Specific event dates will be announced once confirmed.
