

Prevent burnt paw pads during the summer months and know when the ground is too hot for your pet!


7 SECOND TEST

Rule of Paw: If it's too hot for your hand, it's too hot for your dog's paws!












Place the back of your hand on the pavement.

Wait seven seconds.

Too hot for you? Don't go for a walk!

86°	135°
87°	143°
102°	167°



Skin damage, it only takes ONE minute!



Avoid mid-day walks, take a stroll during cooler hours in the early mornings or in the evenings.

It's important to limit your pet's exercise on hot days to prevent them from overheating.

Invest in protective dog boots to prevent injury from hot pavement or harsh weather conditions.

Walk in grassy areas and avoid hot surfaces such as pavement, artificial grass, and sand.
