In order that interested parties have an opportunity to speak, any person addressing the Agency will be limited to a maximum of 5 minutes unless the Chairperson of the ASAC grants a longer period of time.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIODS: Matters under the jurisdiction of the ASAC, and not on the posted agenda, may be addressed by the general public at the beginning of the regular agenda and any off-agenda matters before the Agency for consideration. However, California law prohibits the ASAC from taking action on any matter which is not on the posted agenda unless it is determined to be an emergency by the ASAC for Stanislaus Animal Services. Any member of the public wishing to address the Agency during the "Public Comment" period shall be permitted to be heard once for up to 5 minutes.
