Dogs must be approved by staff. A list of preapproved dogs is updated every Wednesday and is available to view at our shelter.



Pick up a shelter dog anytime before 2 PM, and return them to the shelter by 4 PM.



Please bring your own slip leash. While we will do our best to provide one, there may be times when they are unavailable. We will provide an "Adopt Me" leash sleeve for your use.
